Contest Rules

1. Concho Valley Electric Cooperative will sponsor two area students on an expense paid trip to Washington, D.C., **June 12 through June 21, 2019.**
2. The contest will be open to any student who is a sophomore, junior, or senior in the school year 2018/2019 in one of these school districts: Lake View, Central, Sterling, Grape Creek, Robert Lee, Bronte, Miles, Veribest, Wall, Christoval, Paint Rock, Lake View, Central, Irion County and Water Valley. Applicants do not have to be dependents of CVEC members.

3. Each contestant will submit an essay not to exceed 500 words on the subject:

You are in charge of the energy efficiency program at your school. Describe ways you would recommend for your school to use electricity more efficiently.

Complete the Youth Tour Application form and submit along with the essay.

3. An independent committee will select the winning essays on the basis of knowledge of the subject, originality, composition, neatness and grammar. Reference materials and other information can be obtained at local high schools, public libraries or online.
4. Essays and applications must be submitted by December 12, 2018.
5. Two winners will be selected from all submitted entries. Entries must be mailed to Concho Valley Electric Cooperative, P.O. Box 3388, San Angelo, TX 76902.
