

## Concho Valley Electric Cooperative Government-in-Action Youth Tour

### Contest Rules

1. Concho Valley Electric Cooperative will sponsor four area students on an expense paid trip to Washington, D.C., June 17 through June 26, 2020.
2. The contest will be open to any student who is a sophomore, junior, or senior in the school year 2019/2020 in one of these school districts: Sterling, Grape Creek, Robert Lee, Bronte, Miles, Veribest, Wall, Christoval, Paint Rock, Lake View, Central, Irion County and Water Valley. **Applicants must be a dependent of a CVEC member.**
3. Each contestant will submit an essay not to exceed 500 words on the subject:

### ***“Electric vs Hybrid Vehicles” Now and in the future?***

The contestant must not write his/her name on the essay. Complete the Youth Tour Application form and submit along with the essay.

4. An independent committee will select the winning essays on the basis of knowledge of the subject, originality, composition, neatness and grammar. Reference materials and other information can be obtained at local high schools, public libraries or online.
5. Essays and applications must be submitted by 5p.m. February 14, 2020.
6. Four winners will be selected from all submitted entries. Entries must be mailed to Concho Valley Electric Cooperative, P.O. Box 3388, San Angelo, TX 76902 or dropped off in our office at 2530 Pulliam St, San Angelo, TX 76905.
7. Winners will be notified by March 3, 2020. One runner-up will be selected in the event a winner cannot make the trip.
